Rules:	Entries must be dropped-off between 9:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, October 12, 2019 at the Skidompha Library, Meeting Hall room (rear entrance) located at 184 Main Street, Damariscotta, ME. All entries must be received and displayed at their assigned table. Late entries cannot be judged, but they are welcome as part of the tasting samples. Private judging will begin at 10:45 a.m. Announcement of winners will be made at 1:00 p.m.
2.	Flour used must be King Arthur Flour. "I confirm that my recipe used King Arthur Flour: <b>YES</b> " ALL entries MUST contain fresh, canned or frozen pumpkin; pumpkin pie spice alone does NOT count. Recipes need not be original.
3.	Each entry must have its own entry form & be accompanied by the complete, typed, recipe including instructions for prep. "My recipe can be included on Damariscotta Pumpkinfest's™ web site: <b>YES</b> "
4.	Bring your dessert ready to serve. You will be provided with table space to display your entry, however you must supply your own utensils for serving. Small servings will be provided to three (3) judges. Judges will evaluate creativity of recipe, preparation, texture, flavor, overall appearance and originality. Please collect your utensils after judging or contact chairman by email for pick up, as we cannot be responsible for them
5.	You must prepare two of the same desserts, one for judging and one for sampling.
6.	Indicate what category for tasting your entry falls under:A: Pies, tarts, crisps, icebox pieB: Cakes, muffins, cupcakes, cheesecake, torte, whoopie pie, rollsC: Cookies, shortbread, browniesD: Puddings, clafoutis, creme brulee, trifle, bread puddingE: Candy, caramels, sauceF: Other

7. Please submit your typed recipe as an E-Mail attachment (preferred), or neatly printed. Recipes that are not legible will be disqualified. Judges need to read recipes so please submit them beforehand. We encourage you to include any personal stories that have meaning to your recipes, or tell the judges why you chose your recipe.
